

The Achievement and International grants will be used to support Kapi'olani Community College's strategic plan in supporting Student LEARNING, Student ENGAGEMENT and Student ACHIEVEMENT. Please create criteria to ensure that grants are identified and awarded to support these areas with the following guidelines:

- Maximum award of \$1,026 per semester
- Enrolled at least 6 credits.
- Award only for Academic Year only (Fall or Spring semester...not summer)
- Classified student in a degree/certificate program.
- There is a maximum of eight semesters that a student may receive this award.
- Priority given to the following students:
 - Residents of the state of Hawai'i
 - Students must not have earned prior degrees
 - Minimum cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA):
 - Student Achievement: 2.5
 - Student Engagement: 2.0
 - Student Learning: 2.0

Departments may waive criteria based on extenuating circumstances (by exception only). If a department elects to exercise this option they should have a process that is fair and equitable. When submitting nominations these students must be identified or else will be automatically denied. Except as specified UH Achievement Grant may be allocated to each department as the respective Vice Chancellor deem fair and reasonable.

**** KAP Agree to Degree:** This is a new recommended program to support KCC's effort in the Agree to Degree Program (or is it 15 to Finish). This program will award a \$500 scholarship/grant to cover the last class to graduate and books for that course. Students must meet the following:

1. Register by July 1st
2. In their last semester to meet degree requirements/graduate
3. At least 3.0 GPA
4. Enrolled at least 15 credits.
