Understanding Aging and Chronic Health Issues

The following topics are addressed from the caregiver perspective: the normal process of aging, chronic health conditions, medication management, nutrition & diet, maintaining independence in activities of daily living and end-of-life care. The focus is on the caregiver and what a caregiver can do as well as promoting as much independence as possible for the elder.

Community, Legal, & Financial Resources for Family Caregivers

This course will address topics related to social and health-related resources for elders and caregivers that are available in the community (e.g. free and fee-for-service). In addition, this course will address common legal issues including power of attorney, Will and Trusts, advanced health care directives, elderly abuse & neglect, financial scams, and mental competency issues. Financial issues will include discussions on the cost of long-term care and the differences between Medicaid and Medicare coverage.

Understanding Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementia

This course will address dementia and specifically Alzheimer's Disease. Topics include the disease process, behavioral management techniques, resources in the community and caregiver stress relief.
