



Prior Higher Education Enrollment of Fall 2014 Transfer Students to Kapi'olani Community College

Methodology

Names and birthdates of transfer students (student type = 'T') to Kapi'olani Community College (KapCC) were extracted from the Operational Data Store (ODS) data warehouse after the fall 2014 census freeze (29 September 2014.) These data were submitted to the National Student Clearinghouse (NSC) with a request for prior attendance information. Records for 970 transfer students were submitted to the NSC, and prior attendance records for 750 transfer students were returned.

Limitations of Methodology

The NSC StudentTracker system provides attendance data for more than 3,500 institutions accounting for more than 98% of the national college enrollment.

Findings

The first table shows the most recent higher education enrollment before the students transferred to KapCC in fall 2014. Over half (53%) of the 750 transfers to KapCC had been enrolled within 1 year of transfer. Almost 10% of the transfers had been out of school for over five years.

The second table shows the number of higher education institutions KapCC transfer students attended before they transferred to KapCC. Two students attended nine institutions before transferring to KapCC, but the majority of transfers only attended one institution prior to KapCC. Over 88% of the 750 transfers attended one or two institutions prior to KapCC.

The third table shows the number of students who transferred from all colleges with at least three transfers to KapCC. These colleges were the most recent school from which the students transferred to KapCC.

The third table shows that 30 institutions sent 519 transfer students to KapCC. These 30 institutions sent 69% of the total transfer students to KapCC. Transfers from any of the University of Hawai'i institutions required a change of home institution to be counted (rather than just attendance.)

The top four transfer institutions were all schools within the University of Hawai'i system. These four schools sent 326 or 43% of

the transfers to KapCC. The top three sending schools from outside the UH system were Hawai'i Pacific University (ranked 5th with 25 students or 3% of the transfers), Heald College (ranked 7th with 18 students or 2% of the transfers), and the online University of Phoenix (ranked 9th with 15 students or 2% of the transfers.) The top three sending schools physically located outside of the state of Hawai'i were American River College, College of Southern Nevada, and Pacific University (tied at 14th with 5 students or 0.7% of the transfers each.)

The fourth table shows a reordering of the 30 sending institutions in the previous table by state rather than the number of students. Of the institutions that sent at least three transfers to KapCC, Hawai'i and California sent 472 students or 63% of the transfers.

The fifth table shows the number of sending institutions in each state. Of the 30 institutions that sent at least three transfers to KapCC, 14 of the institutions were located in Hawai'i (47%) and six were located in California (20%), and the remaining sending institutions were located in seven other states.

Additionally, 17 (57%) of the institutions that sent at least three transfers to KapCC were 4-year institutions, and the majority of the 30 sending institutions also were public rather than private schools (67% vs. 33%.)
